

Uniform Code - Senior School

Summer uniform is worn in Terms 1 and 4, winter uniform in Term 2 and 3. Summer or winter uniform may be worn during changeover during the first two weeks of Term 2 and 4.

Regulation Uniform for Year 9-11

Blazer

Cardigan

Black T-bar shoes or black leather lace-up shoes as sold by Black Watch House

Backpack – navy, black

Summer Wear

Black Watch uniform – 2 tops to 1 skirt

White ribbed ankle socks with turn-down cuffs

Sandals – optional (McKinlays Hiker style)

Winter Wear

Black Watch tartan tunic

White blouse (pointed collar) – Year 9-11

Blue blouse (optional) – Year 11 only

Black Watch tartan tie

Black tights

Regulation scarf – optional

PE Uniform

Sports bag with:

- Regulation PE shorts
- Regulation PE shirt
- Black leggings – optional
- Bathing suit – St Cuthbert's regulation
- Bathing cap – House colour
- Navy baseball cap
- White-soled sports shoes
- White socks

Sports Uniform

- Correct regulation code attire
- Track pants – optional
- Track jacket – optional
- Navy polar fleece – optional
- Navy hoodie – optional
- Black undershorts – optional

Optional Items

- Navy anorak
- Umbrella – green, black – optional

Note:

- Summer skirt and winter tunic must be worn at knee length (uniform must sit on the knee until the end of Year 11 so please purchase accordingly)
- Cardigans must NOT be worn on the street at any time
- Blazers must be worn on the street with full winter uniform – shirt sleeves not permitted
- No jewellery or nail polish

Clearings – Black Watch House sells approved clearings. These may be worn by Middle and Senior School students until their ears have healed from piercing. They are not to be worn past the point the girls' ears have healed, they may ONLY be worn for one piercing per ear and that piercing must be in the lower ear lobe, it will be the girls' responsibility to remove them for PE and for sports as staff will not be able to supervise or ensure removal.

- Regulation College Code attire is required for sporting events
- Blazers are to be worn at Cultural Honours, Colours Dinner, representing the College, Open Day, Scholars' Assembly, Term 2 and Term 3 House Chapel services, special group photos and other official functions as advised.

Summer uniform is worn in Term 1 and 4, winter uniform in Term 2 and 3. Summer or winter uniform may be worn during changeover during the first two weeks of Term 2 and 4.

Year 12 Senior Academy Uniform

Compulsory Items

College blazer
Long blue skirt (ankle length)
Long sleeved white shirt
Black Watch tartan tie

Optional Items

Short blue skirt (knee length)
Short sleeved shirt
Senior Academy cardigan

Shoes

- Regulation T-bar shoes or black leather lace-ups as sold by Black Watch House. Please note, any shoes that look like sports shoes are not permitted (even if they are leather) in leather Vans, Keds or Converse or similar (note: any questions or concerns, please check with your Dean prior to purchasing)

Tie

- Black Watch tartan must be worn at all times with both long sleeved shirt and short sleeved shirt

Cardigan

- Grey/navy – may be worn on the street outside the College

Socks/Tights

- Summer – short white socks
- Winter – black tights

Scarf

- Regulation scarf

Jewellery

- No earrings or other jewellery is permitted
- Clearings – Black Watch House sells approved clearings. These may be worn by Middle and Senior School students until their ears have healed from piercing. They are not to be worn

Compulsory Items

Optional Items

Short blue skirt (knee length)
Short sleeved shirt
Senior Academy cardigan

Shoes

Colour Black
Fabric Leather
Style Low heel, closed toe
Summer Sandals may be worn but they must have a solid back or wide strap

The following are not permitted:

- Slave sandals with straps around the ankle
- Skate shoes/beach shoes/sport shoes (even if they are leather) i.e. no leather Vans, Keds or Converse or similar (note: any questions or concerns, please check with your Dean prior to purchasing)
- Boots
- Any shoes with coloured attachments/strips

Year 13 Tie

- Optional
 - can be worn with the long sleeve and short sleeve shirt but not a requirement
- Compulsory
 - must be worn with formal and dress uniforms

Cardigan

- Grey/navy - may be worn on the street outside the College

Socks/Tights

- Summer
 - short white socks or bare legs
- Winter
 - black tights

Scarf

- Chosen by the year group in the preceding year

Earrings

- Small pearl, gold, silver, precious stones studs
- One per ear
- No other piercings

- Long blue skirt

- Socks/tights
 - Summer - short white socks or bare legs
 - Winter - black tights

Dress Uniform

- Socks/tights
 - Summer - short white socks or bare legs
 - Winter - black tights

YOUR HAIR may be worn loose or tied back.
